

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STOKE LYNE PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads – is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** on the unnamed road through the hamlet of Bainton, replacing in full the existing 30mph speed limit, but also extending south- westwards by a further 605 metres, replacing that length of 60mph National speed limit in the process.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Stoke Lyne Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2024 will be revoked/replaced as required.
