

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STOKE LYNE PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Stoke Lyne Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Stoke Lyne Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2024 is revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit:

Stoke Lyne

The whole length of every road in the village of Stoke Lyne extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Stratton Audley Road (east of The Close)	a point 213 metres east of its junction with The Close
b)	Stratton Audley Road/The Green (west of The Close)	a point 188 metres west of its junction with The Close
c)	The unnamed road running northwards out of the village	a point 289 metres northwest of its junction with The Close
d)	The unnamed road running westwards out of the village	a point 145 metres west of its junction with The Close.

Bainton

e)	The unnamed road running in a general northeast / southwest direction through the hamlet	from a point 15 metres east of its junction with the access to 'Home Farm' in Bainton, south-westwards	for a distance of 770 metres.
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SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit

Stoke Lyne

a)	The unnamed road running northwards out of the village	from a point 289 metres north-west of its junction with The Close, northeast & north-westwards	for a distance of 345 metres.
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Bainton

b)	The unnamed road running in a general northeast / south-westerly direction through the hamlet	from a point 96 metres west of its junction with Bainton Farm, north-eastwards	for a distance of 166 metres.
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SCHEDULE 3

40mph speed limit:

Stoke Lyne

a)	Stratton Audley Road (east of The Close)	a point 213 metres east of its junction with The Close, south-eastwards	for a distance of 300 metres.
b)	The Green	from a point 188 metres west of its junction with The Close, westwards	to its junction with the B4100
c)	The unnamed road running westwards out of the village	from a point 145 metres west of its junction with The Close, westwards	to its junction with The Green.

SCHEDULE 4

50mph speed limit

Stoke Lyne

a)	B4100 between the A43 (Brackley Road) and Bicester	From a point from a point 100 metres southeast of its Junction with the A43, south- eastwards	to a point 100 metres southeast of its junction with the un-named road to Stoke Lyne.
